We can accommodate up to 40 for a wedding breakfast in the house or larger numbers in a marquee in the Old Deer Park.

WEEKDAY WEDDINGS

In addition to weekend weddings, Prince Hill House is also available on weekdays for use as an intimate venue for civil wedding celebrations.

The Ceremony

MARRIAGE CEREMONIES & CIVIL PARTNERSHIPS

The Superintendent Registrar from Wiltshire Council will conduct the legal Marriage or Civil Partnership Ceremony.

It is the couple's responsibility for booking the Superintendent Registrar to attend the Civil Ceremony and pay the Registrar's fee direct to the Registration Office.

CHURCH WEDDINGS: CHRIST CHURCH, WORTON

Christ Church is available to couples not resident in the parish but who have qualifying connections;

Christ Church, Worton is a five-minute walk along the leafy public footpath that runs below the end of our garden. It is situated at the end of Church Lane, off Worton High Street just a few hundred yards from Prince Hill House.

For visitor locating purposes, the church is at the end of Church Lane, postcode SN10 5SH.

The leading man behind the building of Christ Church in 1841 was Charles Snell Kensington, who donated land for the church to the west of his house, Lyttlecourt, now known as Prince Hill House. Christ Church Worton and Marston is part of Wellsprings Benefice in the Diocese of Salisbury within the Church of England.

The Grand Hall & Staircase



The moment you walk through the front door into the Grand Hall with its beautiful polished oak floor, oak panelling and pillars, your breath is taken away by the stunning oak staircase. You cannot help but imagine yourself descending the stairs on your wedding day and picture the fabulous photographs that will capture this moment for evermore whilst you admire yourself in the ornate gilt-framed mirror adorning the wall in front of you.

Friends and family can stand in the hall looking up the stairs whilst the bridal couple stand halfway up the staircase for the ceremony.

The Gallery & Stairs



Oak panelling and original oak polished floors continue throughout the landing. While the bridal couple stand halfway down the stairs, friends and family may stand above on the landing looking down upon the ceremony whilst more guests look up from the hall!

There is also a charming recessed window area on the landing where the bridal couple can stand to be married framed by the light pouring in from three sides.

The Study



The Study is an elegantly decorated and furnished cosy room, perfect for an intimate ceremony for a small group. Light streams into this south-facing double aspect room with wooden floors, stripped pine shutters and window seats. There is also an open fireplace with stone surround and marble slips and hearth.

A door leads to the Prince Rupert Portico making it ideally located as an anti-room for the bride or groom to approach either the ballroom or Portico for the ceremony.

This is also the designated room in which the Registration Officers can meet with the bridal couple before the ceremony.

The Ballroom



With original parquet flooring and three sets of French windows leading onto the Prince Rupert Portico and garden, this room oozes grandeur and elegance.

The walls are adorned with duck egg and gold wallpaper and the windows dressed in silk swags and tails. The cut glass chandelier is reflected in the stunning, gilt framed mirror, the larger sister to the mirror in the Grand Hall.

The Ballroom lends itself perfectly to either the marriage ceremony or just for the Wedding Breakfast for up to 40 guests.

OUTDOOR CEREMONIES

Prince Hill House is licensed for civil ceremonies with a choice of 2 areas within the grounds of the main house.



The Harold Peto Octagon Pavillion

(Bridal couple plus 2 witnesses only)



Designed by Harold Peto in 1913, signifying Harold Peto's signature, this enchanting octagonal summerhouse is situated amongst the trees on the eastern perimeter of the garden.

It is constructed of brick with a slate roof and has interior panelling echoing that of the Grand Hall in the main house. There are two sets of double doors, "In" and "out" and three sash windows. The exterior walls boast white Italian marble plaques and a profile head, Roman and Renaissance artefacts brought back from Italy by Peto in the early 1900's.

The Prince Rupert Portico
(Bridal couple plus up to 6 under the portico)





Facing East, this pillared portico lies outside the Ballroom. The ground is paved and there is a wall mounted plaster plaque depicting Prince Rupert to whom it is believed Prince Hill played host when he fought on the side of the Royalists during the Battle of Bristol in 1643.

The house was later named Prince Hill previously having been known as Lyttlecourt. There are three sets of French doors onto the Portico from the Ballroom with the formal lawn beyond. Above is the balcony to the Churchill Suite. There is also a door leading onto the Portico from The Study, the room where the Superintendent Registrar will normally hold a meeting with the couple immediately prior to the ceremony.

The Reception

House Wedding Breakfast (max 40)

Music Room only (max 100)

Marquee in Old Deer Park (larger numbers)



With far reaching views across to Salisbury Plain, the Old Deer Park makes a superb location for the Wedding Breakfast marquee with the Music Room available for catering and dance floor.





POST CEREMONY DRINKS & PHOTOGRAPHS

Three acres of beautiful historical gardens wrap around Prince Hill House. Designed in 1913 by Harold Peto, the grounds feature the Octagon Pavillion, pond, rose garden and walled former kitchen garden. The grounds are full of interest throughout the seasons whether it be daffodils early in the year, richly scented roses during the midsummer months, wisteria & lavender climbing the pergola or the autumn colours of the parkland trees.

Accommodation



THE MAIN HOUSE

Sleeps 18 including the Bridal Suite

There are eight double or twin guest bedrooms on the upper two floors of the main house plus one single and extra put-up beds for small children, providing comfortable accommodation for 18 members of the wedding party. Guests staying only on the wedding night are encouraged to check in as early as they would like to on the day to settle in with plenty of time to prepare for the proceedings.

For guests staying two nights, on the day of the wedding breakfast will be served in the dining room for those staying in the suites on the first floor. Guests in the Prince Rupert and Penthouse suites will have breakfast provisions supplied for them in their individual kitchenettes. Continental breakfast is served for all household guests in the Ballroom on the morning after the wedding. Bacon sandwiches can be served in addition to the continental breakfast.

The Bridal Suite

The Eisenhower



The Eisenhower Bridal Suite at Prince Hill House is located in its own private wing of the house, at the top of the Grand Staircase. Overlooking the gardens and parkland beyond, it offers a spacious, light-filled bedroom with adjacent Bridal Dressing Room, magnificent en-suite bathroom with bateau bath and in/out shower, all providing an ideal space for pre-wedding preparations and sumptuous accommodation on the wedding night.

The Bridal Suite is available for preparations on the morning of the wedding whether or not you choose to stay with us on the previous night.

THE CARRIAGE HOUSE

Sleeps 8 persons max + infant

STABLE COTTAGE

Sleeps 5 persons max + infant



The Carriage House and Stable Cottage provide characterful and comfortable accommodation with flexible configuration over double, twin and single bedrooms.

The Carriage House has an en-suite shower room plus family bathroom with bath and shower. Stable Cottage has a family bathroom with bath and shower plus a downstairs WC.

Both cottages have fully equipped kitchens, sitting rooms and private courtyard garden making them an ideal space in which to relax and prepare for the wedding day subject to availability. The fridges will be stocked with breakfast provisions.

Please note, use of the Carriage house and Stable Cottage are subject to availability and an additional rental charge.

Budgeting for Your Wedding
